A TOTAL of RM815 million worth of affordable property projects will be launched in Klang Valley, Johor, Perak and Negri Sembilan next year, said property developer Hua Yang Bhd.

The company will launch its Klang Valley development projects in Desa Pandan and Shah Alam — comprising of serviced apartments and retail units, said general manager Yuen Kam Mon.

Hua Yang aims to develop affordable projects to meet the demands of the mass market, without compromising the quality of its facilities. He said the company's priority is to build

more quality homes for the people.

“At Hua Yang, we are not only building houses that are affordable, but we also want to create a home that residents will enjoy.”

At present, the company's main projects are focused within Klang Valley, Seremban, Johor Baru and Ipoh,

he added.

Meanwhile, Hua Yang recently announced the successful delivery of the completed Symphony Heights, the company's first high-rise project, within the targeted time frame.

The apartment launched in 2008, has since been fully sold out.
