Oval forms part of Parcel One and comprises 64 units of cluster homes and two units of link bungalows. This development is strategically located within Iskandar Malaysia's eastern corridor where demand for affordable homes are on the rise. The cluster homes are of 2,170 sq ft and priced RM680,000 each while the link bungalows are 2,569 sq ft in size with a price of RM905,995. The group will be launching Parcel Two of Oval, comprising 44 cluster homes and two link bungalows in January next year.

According to Hua Yang, there will be a series of special events planned throughout next year in line with the new launch, starting with The Unicorn World on January 12.

centre and close to Singapore, Citywoods gives residents the opportunity to take in a breathtaking view of the Singapore skyline and the straits of Johor from their apartments. Units are sized from  $764\,\mathrm{sg}$  ft (two-bedroom), with prices starting from RM426,000.

For those seeking to own a business in Johor, there is TPH-Link which comprises 87 units of double storey shop offices, located within Hua Yang's Taman Pulai Hijauan township. Limited Bumi units are available in Parcel One while Parcel Two, which is strategically facing Skudai-Pontian Highway, is now open for sale.
