"We initiated the project in 2006 under a build, operate and transfer (BOT) agreement. Work began in 2008 and was completed this year," said chief executive officer Ho Wen Yan at its recent official opening.

Oasis 9 is a two-storey, 30,000sq ft commercial complex located near Concorde Hotel in Section 9, that provides a venue for small and medium businesses with shop lots, food court, bazaar and a car park.

Its anchor tenant Zam Zam Restaurant, which takes up two floors of the complex, is said to be the country's biggest Arabian restaurant occupying 18,000sq ft and capable of catering 1,000 people at any one time.
